Examinee conduct and cheating on the CMA exam

CHEATING

Examinees who are caught cheating during the exam will have their grades invalidated and will be expelled from the CMA® (Certified Management Accountant) program. Cheating includes:

- copying answers
- using unauthorized materials
- helping another candidate during the exam
- removing exam materials from the testing room
- disclosing exam questions to others
- falsifying credentials

SHARING QUESTIONS

Sharing CMA multiple-choice and essay exam questions with others after taking the exam is a violation of ICMA's examinee conduct policy and is considered cheating.

COPYRIGHT VIOLATION

A CMA candidate who reproduces, reuses, or distributes CMA materials without prior authorization from the publisher is subject to legal action as well as expulsion from the CMA program.

Violation of these policies is also a violation of IMA's ethics policy and will result in expulsion from IMA® (Institute of Management Accountants).
